Part 1

2. Experiment with the <HR> tag. Make sure to investigate the different attributes.
3. Figure out what the <I> tag does.
4. Review the text formatting tags that you already learned (for example,).
5. Make a list of 6 of your favorite books. Use the and tags for a bulleted list, or the and tags for a numbered list.
6. Review the <A> tag, which is used to create links. Make a link to one of your favorite sites.
7. Review the difference between the
 and <P> tags.
8. What does the <BLOCKQUOTE> tag do?
