

Intro to Computer Science :: Web Design :: WYSIWYG Editors

Now that you have had an introduction to a WYSIWYG (pronounced *whizzywig*; it stands for What You See Is What You Get) web page editor, it's time to get some practice in using it.

Assignment:

Use Dreamweaver to make a web page that displays your class schedule. (This should be easier than it was to do in raw HTML.)

Requirements:

- Label your schedule; include your name somewhere on the page.
- Put your free periods in red, lunch in blue. There does not have to be a border between table cells, but periods must be readily differentiated.
- You must include clip art (minimum of one picture per course on your schedule). Discovery School's Clip Art Gallery is a good place to start, or use Google's image search.
- Make your page visually attractive.
- All files for this assignment must be in a folder called *yourname**web3***
